## Bozeman Pond to West Side Trail Connector

### Project Description:

This project will create a new 770-foot trail behind the Mall connecting the northeast corner or the Bozeman Pond loop trail to the south end of the West Side Trail. Currently trail users must walk or bike through traffic in the Mall parking lot to connect between these two heavily-used trails. The need for this trail has become particularly timely because in Fall 2010, Bozeman Pond was connected to the MSU campus with a new paved trail that runs from College & 11<sup>th</sup> to Huffine & Ferguson.

### Project Status:

We have completed the trail design and engineering and are currently negotiating a trail easement with the Mall and working to secure the funding needed to complete the project. We plan to construct the trail in Spring 2011.

**Projected Project Cost: \$12,000**

Includes moving the chain link fence and grading the berm around the Mall's detention pond.

**Funding Needed: \$5,000**

### Partners & Sponsors:

We have received a \$4,810 Bozeman Parkland Improvement Grant and over \$2,000 in donated engineering services from Allied Engineering.
