

TEMPORARY SPECIAL ORDER – TRAIL USE RESTRICTION

CHESTNUT MOUNTAIN TRAIL No. 458

**GALLATIN NATIONAL FOREST
BOZEMAN RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the following National Forest System (NFS) lands, roads and trails of the Gallatin National Forest. These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and become effective upon signing and will remain in effect until rescinded.

36 CFR 261.55(a)– NFS Trails

It is prohibited being on a trail.

Beginning **January 2, 2012** until rescinded the following is prohibited:

It is prohibited for any person to be upon the **Chestnut Mountain Trail No. 458** as it crosses private lands within Section 20, T. 2 S., R. 7 E., P.M. MT as shown on the attached map.

The purpose of the closure is to protect public safety during active logging operations occurring on private lands which are adjacent to the Chestnut Mountain Trail No. 458. Logging operations are anticipated to be completed by January 13, 2012.

Exemptions:


Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this restriction:

1. Persons with a permit issued by a forest officer specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Penalty:

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571).
