### HERE'S HOW IT WORKS:

1. Maximum team size is four people, and come up with a creative team name.
2. Teams earn points by doing one or all of the following:

**RECRUIT donors.**

Each contribution (**minimum \$10**) must be turned in at the event to count.

**1 point/donor: 75 point cap**

**RAISE MONEY** - turn in money day of

Turn in paid pledges at registration, securing per-kilometer pledges is not allowed.

**1 point/\$50 raised: 75 point cap**

**SKI during the event.**

Registration and team skiing is from 8:30am - 3pm, there is food and drink through out the day

**1 point/4 km skied: 50 point cap**

3. Each team must raise a **minimum of \$200** (\$50 per person). This can come as donations from team members, a team sponsor, individuals, or a combination. This minimum entitles each team member to participate in Make Tracks for Trails event, receive a 2012 MT4T Sauce headband, \$15 Gift Certificate to Ale Works, and earn one entry per team member for the raffle. Team members are eligible to compete in the top individual fundraiser categories, make sure you have your name listed on your pledge forms.
4. Each team must designate a captain who is responsible for registering the team, turning in the pledge forms and paid pledges, and recording the kilometers skied at the end of the day.
5. Skiers register and ski between 8:30a.m. and 3 p.m. The winning team will be announced at the **Make Tracks for Trails PARTY** at 3:30 p.m. *If there is a tie, the winning team will be drawn at random.*
